## RiverPointe Post-Acute communication update related to Covid-19.

We are deeply committed to the health and safety of our residents and staff members. In an effort to provide the most current updates we will be uploading all Covid-19 related updates on our website RiverPointePostAcute.com. We only post updates when there is a change in confirmed positive cases or two or more people exhibiting signs or symptoms.

We communicate daily with CDC, CDPH, and local county health department. They work closely with us to manage Covid-19 mitigation. At this time we have activated our Covid-19 Positive Wing in accordance with our state approved mitigation plan. Residents who have tested positive are being cared for by our special covid-19 designated team who only work in this wing.

## **Resident and Staff Status**

The information below is updated regularly to help ensure residents, family, and the community are kept up to date on our current COVID-19 status. In the event of a positive case as well as suspected signs and symptoms of residents or staff we have a mitigation plan in place to protect our residents and team members.

There are currently 15 confirmed, COVID-19 positive residents in our COVID-19 isolation unit. This is an increase of 7 since the last time we conducted weekly response-driven testing.

There are currently 14 team members who are unavailable to work because of a COVID-19 positive test. Many staff and residents are nearing their recovery period.

Since January 1, 2020, there have been 15 residents\* and 14 team members who have tested positive for COVID-19.

\*Cumulative resident case count does not include cases that originated outside of the facility.
